School Age (K-5) Child Care

Contributors to the YMCA Annual Campaign who wish to designate their funds for use in, licensed, YMCA Child Care programs may choose to take advantage of the State of Colorado Child Care Tax Credit. The YMCA will use gifts designated to child care to provide financial assistance to families who are unable to pay full child care program fees and towards the training of child care professionals. Designed to promote child care in Colorado, this credit can make a significant impact on the actual cost of your donation. When you combine the state tax credit with federal and state tax deductions, your gift can cost you as little as 30 cents on the dollar.

How a \$1,000 gift to the YMCA really only costs you \$295
